





First External of the Year:



➤ The Loran Award is valued at \$100,000

➤ This year, 36 Loran Awards

> 95 finalist and provincial & territorial awards (\$5,000 or \$2,000 each, respectively) to promising candidates.

Eligibility Criteria for High School Students

- Be in your final year of uninterrupted full-time studies in high school.
- Present a minimum cumulative average of 85%.
- Hold Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status.
- Be at least 16 years of age by September 1st of the following year.

- Integrity, Courage and Leadership
- Community Service
- Academic Achievement

Entrance Scholarships

- Money given to outstanding new students from the university or college that they will be attending. Students must "excel across the board".
- Criteria for these scholarships may be based on any, all or a combination of:
 - Academic Excellence (GPA)
 - Community Involvement (ex. leadership, school and/or community service)
 - ☐ Financial Need (optional)
 - ☐ Impressive Written Personal Profile



Example: Centennial Scholars Entrance Award

- The value of the awards can range up to \$80,000 which will will cover the full cost of your degree and living expenses.
- The <u>application for the award is available online</u> and is due by **December 1, 2021**, which is also the deadline for your <u>application of early admission to UBC</u>.
- Application includes:
- -Family financial Situation (including information from parents)
- -Essay of your Financial Hardshp
- -Reference forms filled out by two referee's



QE INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS

- Money that is given to your school from various community organizations/companies/etc. to be distributed amongst qualifying Grade 12 students.
- Students must complete a survey in May 2022 to be eligible Locate on our QE Careers Website
- Criteria for selection includes:
 - ☐ GPA (often Grade 11 and 12)
 - Teacher References
 - School Involvement (extra-curricular, clubs, sports, etc.)
 - Community Involvement (volunteering, etc.)
 - Financial Need
 - Attendance / Lates in Grade 12 Year
 - Student Essay / Letter of Intent

District / Authority Scholarships

- > 5,500 awards of \$1,250 available to schools throughout the province
- ➤ 2020 QE Received 28
- ➤ These scholarships reward graduating BC students for excellence in a variety of fields.
- > Teacher Nominated

District / Authority Scholarships, cont'd.

➤ To be eligible, students are required to demonstrate superior achievement in any of the following areas:

FINE ARTS – Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music	INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGES – International Languages Curriculum
APPLIED DESIGN, SKILLS AND TECHONOGIES – Business, Technology, Home Economics, and Information Communication Technology	TECHNICAL TRADES & TRAINING – Carpentry, Automotive, Mechanics, Culinary/Cook Training
PHYSICAL ACTIVITY – Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, not limited to Physical Education	COMMUNITY SERVICE (Volunteer Activity) – Includes awareness of local, global and cultural issues
INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES & CULTURE Demonstrated at school or in the community
